Galloway Flowers are committed to minimising the negative environmental impact of our business. Our Environmental & Sustainability Policy aims to integrate sustainable development into all the Galloway Flowers activities & to establish & promote sound environmental practice in our operations.

We'll achieve this by;

- Complying with relevant legislation & regulations
- Being an environmentally responsible neighbour in the community
- Growing most of our flowers on site at Balmaclellan with remainder supplied by growers in the British Isles to reduce 'Flower Miles'.
- Growing without the use of harsh chemicals & instead encourage natural pest controllers such as hedgehogs, frogs, toads, hoverflies etc.
- Use minimal packaging & attempt to use recyclable methods & materials when possible
- Review the environmental impact of our activities regularly, minimise our overall negative impact & actively seek to reduce waste over time. Any plastic waste generated will be disposed of with care & using best practice techniques
- Develop projects to protect & where possible, enrich the site for mutual benefit with the wildlife sharing this place
- Work with suppliers & customers to reduce waste
- Enhancing awareness among our customers – educating & motivating them to act in an environmentally responsible manner & raising awareness of 'Flower Miles'
- Where practicable, we'll provide information & assistance to customers on environmental issues arising from our activities.
